SCTNow Volunteer Raises \$11,200 for SCTNow

An abolitionist with a heart to make a difference, that's Elisha Krauss, a 24-year-old newlywed and New York resident who used her long hair as a way to raise over \$10,000 to end child trafficking. Elisha launched the "10 for 10" campaign, with the ambition to cut off an inch of her hair for every \$1,000 she raised--all the money donated to Stop Child Trafficking Now.

Elisha raised \$11,200 in under one month. She said, "I couldn't have done it without you all. Your support, monies and spreading the word worked! That money will go far in helping to stop child trafficking and bringing justice and freedom to thousands of children here in the United States and abroad who are trapped every single day."
